Orunodoi (or Arunodoi) was the first Assamese-language monthly magazine, published from Sibsagar in 1846. It marked the beginning of modern Assamese literature by promoting the Assamese language and nurturing writers such as Anandaram Dhekial Phukan, Hemchandra Barua, and Gunabhiram Barua. The magazine covered current affairs, science, history, and literature, while also serving as a medium for Christian missionary work.
