Oudh Punch was an Urdu satirical weekly published in Lucknow between 1877 and 1937. Founded and edited by Munshi Sajjad Husain, it was inspired by the London-based magazine Punch, from which it derived its name. It became one of the earliest Indian publications to use political satire, often criticizing British colonial rule.
